District Athletics

37 KS2 children went to the USSP District Athletics competing against children from other similar sized primary schools from the district. The boys took on the field events first, claiming first or second in 8 out of the 12 events, whilst the girls took on the track events. As the girls and boys swapped disciplines, the team's position was looking strong. The girls performed even better than the boys on the field coming first or second place in 9 out of the 12 events, and the boys continued their strong performance by coming first or second in 5 of the 8 track events.

A great performance so far and only the relays to go – three wins and two second places out of the 8 relays. The children were so excited as they gathered for final results. The year 3 and 4 results were announced – first to LHS – then the Year 5 and 6 – first again to LHS. So there was no surprise, when we came away as overall winners of the District Athletics competition.

A special mention to the Year 6 boys team, who won 6 out of the 7 events; to the year 3 boys who came 1st in 3 of their events and 2nd in their other 2 events; and to Samantha Dadd and Jack Hart who both came second in the high jump, despite having never done the event before!

Cricket against HBO

This was the last of our group matches, and we played really well to win 169 to 87 – winning the group. We are looking forward to the semi-final against Northgate next week.

So far all members of Year 6 and all members of the after school cricket club have had the chance to play in at least one cricket tournament, and 21 children have had the opportunity to represent the school in the after school matches!
